REGISTRATION/CENSUS INFORMATION

In the Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah School District, three-year-old screenings are conducted throughout the school year on Friday mornings. Children who turn three-years-old during the school year are screened close to the month of their birthday. The screening gives parents an opportunity to learn more about the development of their child while giving school staff the chance to screen for any developmental delays. All of this is done to allow for earlier intervention which provides the child a greater chance for success in school.

During the screening, parents sit down with an interviewer and talk about their child while the youngster is encouraged to participate in a play group where social, communication, motor and early learning skills are observed. The screening takes about 45 minutes. **We are asking again this year, that** <u>if you have a child who will turn</u> <u>three years old</u> during this school year (between September 1, 2022 and August 31, 2023), that he or she be registered for the district three-year-old screening when you register your other children for school.
