

TITLE I PROGRAM

The Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah School District utilizes federal Title I program funds to provide educational support for elementary students identified as being able to benefit from additional assistance in the academic areas. In addition to receiving support while at school, the district recognizes the importance of parent/guardian involvement in the educational process. The district will provide opportunities for the parents/guardians to become involved in the design and implementation of district Title I program activities and in improving the academic achievement and school performance of their children, whenever appropriate.
